**All applications to the Junior Infants in Cuan na Gaillimhe CNS-A Steiner Education will only be accepted from the 20<sup>th</sup> October 2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 9<sup>th</sup> January 2026. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.**

**All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class in Cuan na Gaillimhe CNS-A Steiner Education will only be accepted from the 02<sup>nd</sup> June 2026 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 29<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy. Equally, any transfer applications received during the current academic year, *i.e.* before June 2026, to transfer into a class immediately, will be treated as a late application where the application window for transferring into the school for the academic year 2025/2026 took place during the previous academic year and anyone who did not receive a place at that time was put on a waiting list. Therefore, any available places that arise in that class**

during the 2025/2026 academic year will be filled from that waiting list, until that list expires at the end of the academic year 2025/2026.

<p>All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class for the following academic year will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:</p>	<p>20<sup>th</sup> July 2026</p>
<p>Successful transfer applicants to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class in the following academic year must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Cuan na Gaillimhe CNS- A Steiner Education by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:</p>	<p>03<sup>rd</sup> August 2026</p>

**Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above, or that stated on any letter of offer, may result in the offer being withdrawn.**
